

Outdoor sports, indoor sports, or festivals, there is something for everyone. Area organizations include numerous clubs and special interest groups ranging from the arts to wrestling. It is truly a place for all season.

#### **Natural Resources!**

The Mora Area is rich with many lakes and rivers for water enthusiasts. The area lakes are: Knife, Ann, Fish, Eleven, Bass, Lewis, Quamba, Lake Five, Full of Fish, Pomroy and Lake Mora. The rivers are; Snake, Knife, Groundhouse, Grindstone, Ann and Rice. The Mora area also offers great hunting and hiking in the Mille Lacs Wildlife Refuge. With the Mille Lacs recreational area in our backyard, Kanabec County is every nature enthusiast's paradise. Beautiful state and city parks are scattered throughout the area providing exquisite settings for picnics, gatherings, sports and hunting.



## **Kanabec History Center**

Established in 1978, the Kanabec History Center hosts a variety of programs and exhibits throughout the year. Open all year, Tuesday through Saturday 10:00 AM to 4:30 PM. The history center provides unique educational programs and workshops throughout the year.

# **Ogilvie Pool**

The Ogilvie pool is located indoors at the Ogilvie School and provides public swimming all year round.

## **Mora Aquatic Center**

Offers a lap pool, a diving pool, three water slides and a shallow pool. Open June through August.



## Mora Civic Center

(Mora Area Youth Recreation Association) MAYRA runs the Mora Civic Center and sponsors youth baseball, softball, flag football, soccer, hockey and figure skating.

The civic center is host to many events throughout the year.

## **Mora Public Library**

A branch of the East Central Regional Library, the Mora Library offers a wide selection of books, reference material and other resource material. Public computers and wireless access available.

#### Nordic Ski Center

A dream come true through private donations and dedicated volunteers. Designed to promote cross country skiing, the center is open in winter and available to be used by activity groups and private events the rest of the year. For information, call 320-679-2629.

## Vasaloppet Headquarters

An attractive Swedish-style building in downtown Mora, across from the Mora Klocka converted from the former Burlington Northern Depot.

## **Ogilvie Tower**

Built in 1918, the Ogilvie water tower was one of the first reinforced concrete water towers built in Minnesota. Designed after the turreted castles of northern Europe, seven window sets located along the bottom portion of the structure give it a picturesque appearance. In 1980, the Ogilvie Tower was placed in the National Register of Historic Places. The tower is located in downtown Ogilvie.



## Paradise Theatre

A not-for-profit community owned theater, the Paradise offers first-run digital movies and provides a location for concerts, stage productions, seminars and other special events. Located in downtown Mora. For information, call 320-679-3964.



#### Courthouse

The historic Kanabec County courthouse was constructed in 1894 after a fire destroyed an earlier wooden structure. It was remodeled in 1999 carefully maintaining and complementing the Romanesque revival design of the 1894 structure. A new jail was added in 2011.

## Kanabec County Fairgrounds

Located on Union Street in Mora, the fairgrounds come alive for five days in July during the Kanabec County Fair. Also located on the fairgrounds are the Mora Civic Center, Mora Aquatic Center and Lions Park. There is something going on all year long.

## **Swedish Landmarks**

#### Mora Klocka

Located in the center of Mora, the twenty foot tall Klocka stands as a symbol of the relationship between sister cities Mora, MN and Mora, Sweden. Erected in 1995 through the initiative of an assistance from the Dala Heritage Society.

#### **Bell Tower**

The thirty nine foot tall Bell Tower sits on the southwest shore of Lake Mora. The Bell Tower was dedicated in 1979. It houses a 200 pound bell that announces the skiers of the Mora Vasaloppet as they cross the lake.

#### Ole

This life-size statue serves as a reminder to all of the annual Vasaloppet ski race. It is located at the junction of Hwys 23E & 65.

#### Dala Horse

The twenty five foot Dala Horse was constructed in the early 1970s by the Mora Jaycees. The intent was to provide the City of Mora with not only a landmark to the city's Swedish heritage, but would also serve as a tourist attraction. The Dala Horse can be found at the entrance of the Kanabec County Fairgrounds.

## **History & Heritage**

Kanabec County is usually classified as one of the newer counties in the state. The territorial legislature authorized creation of the county from a part of Pine County in 1858. Kanabec County received its name from W. H. Folsom, who authored the bill in the state legislature creating the county. The word "kanabec" is from the Ojibway "snake". The Snake River served as a "highway" for loggers and trappers to transport their goods.

Brunswick was the first county seat. In 1876, the first courthouse was constructed and occupied until 1883 when the county seat was moved to Mora.

Logging and potato farming were the primary means of economic development in early Kanabec County.



Today, Kanabec County's population has a strong Swedish heritage. Located just an hour from the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area, it is where many commuters call home. The community has done an excellent job of retaining its values. Commitment to family, education, excellent health care, strong work and business ethics, and an enthusiastic community spirit provide our residents an exceptionally rich quality of life.

#### **Outdoor Activities:**

Fishing: Kanabec County boasts 41 lakes and hundreds of miles of river habitat. Within these waters almost every species of fish in Minnesota can be found.

Lakes: Several of the area lakes, including Knife Lake, Fish Lake and Ann Lake, are shallow foliage lakes with fish populations connected to river ways. For public access information, please see map section of our guide.

Rivers: The most prominent of rivers, the Snake offers quality fishing and canoeing. The Ann River and Rice Creek, which both feed the Snake, also offer good fishing numbers as does the Knife River in the northwest, which feeds into Knife Lake.

Canoeing: One of the most popular canoe rivers in the state, the Snake River flows through Kanabec County. The Snake River offers canoe excitement for both the white water and gentle water enthusiast.

White Water: The upper Snake River from Aitkin County down to Mora contains some difficult rapids. White water is most exciting during the spring run off of late April and early May. Only experienced canoeists should attempt this stretch.

Gentle Waters: For less experienced paddlers, the stretch of river between Mora and Pine City flows gently through wooded banks and rolling valleys. While other parts of the river may be too shallow to canoe in the summer, this route is almost always passable.

Hunting: Kanabec County is a hunter's paradise few areas can match. Among public hunting lands, the area offers the Ann Lake Wildlife Management Area, Mille Lacs Wildlife Management Area and the Rum River State Forest. Kanabec County offers excellent deer, bear and bird populations.

ATV: Kanabec County has plenty for the avid ATV enthusiast. Miles and miles of picturesque scenery, a good time can be had by all.

Boating: Area lakes provide boaters plenty of opportunity to play. Whether pontoon or speed boat, several lakes provide excellent water-skiing, boarding and tubing for your summertime activities.



Snowmobiling: Ideal snowmobiling can be found on groomed trails, logging roads and in state forests. Marked trails are available for public use. The beauty of snowmobiling here combines with the networking of trails that connect to other parts of the state. Local trails are groomed and maintained by E C Riders Snowmobile Club, 320-679-1383.

**Cross Country Skiing:** Kanabec County has one of the largest cross country ski traditions in the nation. Two unique and beautiful trails are open for skiing throughout the winter. One located at the Kanabec History Center and the other, the 58K Vasaloppet trail, which includes lighted trails and extensive practice loops on the northern section of the trails. The trails are maintained by hundreds of local volunteers. The Mora Vasaloppet International Cross Country Race is held on this course and is one of the premier races in

# Vora Area Visitors Guide





#### **Bass Lake**

This 230 acre lake is located in the far northeast corner of Kanabec County, where it meets with Aitkin and Pine Counties.

Panfish are plentiful, so come prepared for crappie and sunfish action. Bass, walleye and northern pike also swim these waters and nice-sized fish are taken. Walleyes don't exist in great numbers here, but those that are caught are good-sized. Similarly, northern pike in this lake are large.

#### Public Access

Public access is on the west side of the lake off 390th St.

#### Lake Eleven

Located in the northeast corner of Kanabec County, in Kroschel Township, near the junction of Cty Rd 20 & 85, Lake Eleven is one of many secluded lakes in the area.

What it lacks in size, it makes up for in numbers of fish. Lake Eleven boasts catches of walleye, northern pike, bass, sunfish and crappies. Walleye fishing has been known to be excellent during the very early summer and late the fall. Eleven has a maximum depth of 13 feet and truly fits the description of a soup bowl type bottom structure. The



lake holds a couple of bottom humps and breaks which seem to attract fish. Shorelines are gradual and offer emergent vegetation as fish cover. Good fishing can be found many times on the northeast side of the lake.

#### Public Access

An earthen ramp is maintained by the DNR on the south shore of the lake just off Cty Rd 32.


#### Lake Full of Fish

Although you must pay a small fee to Camperville Resort to enter this lake, Full of Fish is a fun lake to visit. This sandy bottomed lake offers fair water clarity and moderate depths. You won't find walleye, but panfish are plentiful so bring lots of worms! If you have something larger in mind, northern pike and largemouth bass are also found in the lake.

#### Lake Five

Located north of Cty Rd 85 in Kroschel Township, Lake Five provides all the major game fish of the area. A good lake to take the kids fishing as panfish are abundant.

The bottom is sand-marl and water clarity is good.





#### Lake Mora

Although the lake is not known for fishing, if you want a place to take the kids, you will find plenty of crappie, panfish and a few northern pike to catch that will make your outing enjoyable.

Lake Mora is a nice, quiet lake for canoeing, picnicking or just enjoying a day at the park.

#### **Lewis Lake**

Located directly south of Ogilvie on Hwy 47 and 14 miles south of Mora in southern Kanabec County, Lewis Lake offers consistent stringers of panfish and an occasional trophy bass or pike. Some of the lake's best panfish fishing seems to be on the north end of the lake at the weed line and on the west across from the public access.

#### Public Access

Located on 110th Ave. just off Hwy 47. Gas, bait, food and other provisions are available in Ogilvie and Mora.

## **Pomrov Lake**

Pomroy is located 8 miles north of Quamba near the junctions of county roads 3 and 5. It is a shallow, weedy lake with tree stumps in the northeast section. It is best known for its abundant northern pike and sunfish. For its size, it produces astounding numbers of fish.

#### Public Access

The state-owned concrete access ramp is located on the east shore off of 290th Ave. The parking area can accommodate 15 vehicles with trailers.

#### Quamba Lake

Quamba Lake (formerly known as Mud Lake) is located just south of Hwy 23 and the city of Quamba. The lake is known for its northern pike and bass fishing and holds a good population of panfish.


The lake has sand-gravel bottom areas as well as marl. Several areas of the lake offer emergent vegetation which makes good cover for game fish.

#### **Public Access**

Access is located just off Cty Rd 5 on Basswood. A concrete ramp provides for easy launching and there is plenty of parking. Gas, bait, food and lodging are available in Mora.




The Vasaloppet USA Cross Country Ski Race is held each year on the second Sunday in February, attracting skiers and visitors from all over the world.


